The Jungle is Alive at Six Flags Great Adventure Balin's Jungleground Play Area Abundant with Treehouses, Animals, and Water Retreats

Denver, Colo. (May 19, 2005) – Guests of Six Flags Great Adventure in Jackson, N.J. will find themselves face-to-face with tigers, elephants and other jungle creatures as the park opens Balin's Jungleground.

KoalaPlay Group, the commercial design and development division of Koala Corp., unfolds its newest storybook as the hallmark to Balin's Jungleground. The company introduced the combination of a dry, water and soft foam play area to originate one of the world's largest play structures.

Elephants, tigers, and crawling vines serve as the backdrop to this mythical kingdom. Families will take a journey through six distinct jungle lands that are all connected with a series of transfer bridges.

The massive play area features Tigerland Treehouses, Splashwater Oasis and Cub's Corner play areas. Tigerland Treehouses are three, multi-tiered towers of excitement housing a number of interactive play elements including SkyTwist™, elephant and tiger slides, cargo nets, web crawls, twist n' tangles and punching bags. Kids will travel through the structure exploring mazes, striking bongo drums and surveying the jungle landscape with telescopes and binoculars. Standing nearly three-stories tall, there are 30 various platforms of fun to enjoy.

Those guests looking to cool off from the summer heat can escape to the Splashwater Oasis. These two water towers are located next to the Tigerland Treehouses and are packed full of water blasters, tipping buckets, slides, jumping fountains, water curtains and more. There is over a thousand gallons of water coursing through these WaterColors™ structures.

Underneath a themed awning, smaller children will enjoy a soft foam play area designed specifically for them. At Cub's Corner kids can slide down elephants and trees, climb on the backs of tigers and touch the playful crocodiles.

"Our innovative approach of incorporating dry, water and soft foam play structures into one massive play area will help Six Flags Great Adventure broaden its appeal to all visitors, increase profits and create the ultimate family recreational experience," said Steve Wagner, vice president of sales and marketing at KoalaPlay Group.

Balin's Jungleground is part of The Golden Kingdom, Six Flags Great Adventure's largest expansion in the park's 31-year history. The Golden Kingdom also includes the addition of

Kingda Ka – the tallest, fastest roller coaster on Earth; the Temple of the Tiger educational exhibit and new shops and eateries.
